Read

Isaiah 6:1-8

Discuss:

- What attribute of God is repeated 3 times? What does this attribute mean?
- When you think about God, what attribute do you often think of?
- In verse 5 what is Isaiah response to seeing the holiness of God?
- When we realize who God is, what should our response be?
- God took away Isaiah sin in verse 7, read 2 Corinthians 5:21 and see why God can take away our sin if we place our faith in Jesus. Discuss.

Memorize:

Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Sing:

Pray:

Praise God his Holiness. Ask God to help you see your sinfulness and need of Jesus.

Luke 5:1-11

Discuss:

- Why did Simon not want to let his nets down when Jesus asked him? What happened when he did?
- What was Peter response in verse 8? Why do you think he did this?
- What can we learn about Jesus from this passage?
- How can you apply this passage to your life? (obey Jesus, see who Jesus truly is, fisher of man, leave sinful life behind and follow Jesus)

Memorize:

Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Sing:

Pray:

Praise Jesus for who he is and ask him to help you be a fisher of men.

Philippians 16:25-34

Discuss:

- What were Paul and Silas doing at midnight in jail? Why do you think they were doing this?
- How can our response to trials/difficulties empower our witness?
- After the earthquake the Philippians jailer asked what question of Paul and Silas? What was their response?
- Is this the same answer today?
- What did the jailer do at once in verse 33 after receiving the word?

Memorize:

Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Sing:

Pray:

Ephesians 2:1-10

Discuss:

- In verses 1-3 how does Paul describe the spiritual condition of those who do not know Jesus?
- What characteristics of God do we see in verses 4-5?
- What do these words mean?
- How are we saved according to verse 8-9?
- How is salvation a gift? What must we do to obtain it?

Memorize:

Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Sing:

Pray:
