The **Top 3 Things** you need to know about Risk Management at FBCT are:

- 1) All volunteers must have a _____ on file in the church office. This includes references and written permission for a background check.
 - a. All volunteers must be _____ by the ministry area leader (minister or ministry assistant).
- 2) _____ is mandatory.
 - a. Additional training will be available to volunteers (CPR & basic First Aid) as it is for paid staff.
 - b. Training protects the children and youth - and you, the volunteer leader / worker.
- 3) Know the **Rules for Risk Management:** (6 rules)
 - a. **The _____ Rule:** Volunteers must be active members of FBC and faithful attenders for a minimum of 6 months prior to service. (Exceptions are made for some larger programs. See your ministry area leader for details or with questions.)
 - b. **The _____ Rule** must be followed at all times. "No individual child/youth is to be alone with one adult or minister at any time." Human hallway monitors make this possible in some scenarios.
 - c. **The _____ Rule:** Couples may serve together only if another approved worker is present in the room or if monitored by a designated hall monitor.
 - d. **The _____ Rule:** Volunteers who are 13 years old and older may participate in the Youth Apprenticeship Program. Guidelines and application are in your manual.
 - e. **The _____ Rule:** A liability release form must be signed by a parent/legal guardian for each child to attend an off-campus activity and/or travel in FBC vehicles. Available from ministry area leaders.
 - f. **The _____ Rule:** Should an incident involving the injury or abuse of a minor be observed at FBC or at a FBC sponsored event the incident must be reported following the reporting guidelines in the manual. Forms are in the manual.
